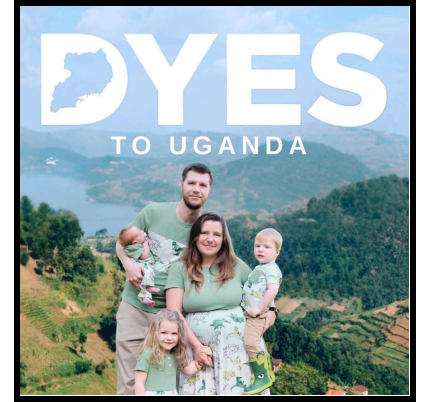


The Dye's Deputation Journey

Our plane tickets have been purchased for us to leave on December 20th to head to the field. We are working on getting our visas for the trip, but we have all our passports, and our yellow fever shots. We are finishing up packing all our boxes and suitcases, and we are overall



very excited to be starting this next part of our journey.

We had a wonderful Thanksgiving with Joel's family. It was a blessing to see some of Joel's cousins who visited from California, but we do ask for prayer for his grandmother, as she was taken to the hospital last week for her vertigo. She is currently home, but we are praying for a quick recovery. We appreciate all the time we have had with family before we leave for the field.

The last 3 months were extremely busy going from South Carolina to Virginia to Illinois to Tennessee to Alabama to

Virginia again, and then to end our

deputation in Ohio. We even flew to Utah for a meeting there, and while at the airport and on the plane, our children kept asking us if we were going to Uganda. It's wonderful to see their excitement to go to a place where God has called us to plant roots and reach the lost people who are desperately needing a relationship with God.

As we make this journey, from Atlanta to Kampala which is a 7,731 mile distance, we ask that you keep us in mind as we find and make our home there in Uganda. We also ask that you pray for this weekend, Sunday, December 8th, as Joel gets ordained at our sending church. We are looking forward to this next step.
